Name of Board/Commission	Community Mental Health Services Board (CMH Board)
Origin	Public Act 258 (1974 as amended)
Appointment Authority	Board of Commissioners Vote
Function	The CMH Board is charged with providing a comprehensive array of mental health services appropriate to needs of the primary consumers located within its service area, regardless of the ability to pay for the service. By statute, the members are representative of providers of mental health services, recipients or consumers of mental health services, agencies and occupations having a working involvement with mental health services and the general public.
Membership Composition	12 members. 2 members must be primary consumers and 2 members must be either primary consumers or family members. All members of must be 18 years of age or older. No more than 4 members may be County Commissioners and not more than 1/2 of the Board may be state, county or local public officials. Board members shall have his or her primary residence in Macomb County. Members cannot be employed by the Community Mental Health Program (CMHP), be a party to a contract, or administer or benefit financially from a contract with CMHP; nor may members serve in policy making positions with an agency under contract with CMHP.
Term	3 years
