Man arraigned for stabbing his son in Eastpointe

Mt. Clemens, MI - Macomb County Prosecutor's Office charged and arraigned Richard Raymond Mayack, 68 years-old, of Eastpointe with assault with intent to murder, a life offense, and domestic violence, a 93-day misdemeanor for stabbing his son.

It is alleged that on Wednesday, November 16, 2022 the accused was in a verbal argument with his son, Vince, age 35, at their home in Eastpointe. During the argument the defendant retrieved a knife and approached his son. The defendant and his son began a physical fight and Richard Mayack stabbed his son in the abdomen and head. The defendant was arrested at the scene and his son was transported to a nearby hospital where he is stable and expected to recover.

"This is a sad situation for the family. A family argument should never escalate to any type of violence," said Macomb County Prosecutor Peter J. Lucido

The defendant was arraigned in Eastpointe District Court on Thursday, November 17, 2022. Assistant Prosecutor Victoria Pollicicchio asked for a \$250,000 cash/surety bond, no 10% with a GPS tether and Magistrate Makoski granted the request.

The Probable Cause Hearing is scheduled for Tuesday, November 29, 2022 at 8:00am and the Preliminary Examination is scheduled for Tuesday, December 6, 2022 at 8:00am in front of Judge Galen.

The Macomb County Prosecutor's office represents the people. We are committed to achieving justice and following the laws of the State of Michigan. All that are accused of a crime are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
