### WHAT IS THE JUVENILE JUSTICE CENTER?

The JJC is a secure residential facility designed to provide pre and post disposition of juvenile criminal cases for juveniles who cannot be placed in a less restrictive setting. The JJC detains youths who have violated the law, violated court orders, and/or violated the conditions of their probation.

#### **RESULTS OF HAVING JUVENILE CRIMINAL CHARGES** EVEN WITHOUT CONVICTION

- Difficulty Obtaining Employment
- Trouble Joining the Military
- Hard to get Accepted to College
- No Financial Aid
- Legal Financial Obligations
- Limited Housing Options
- No Public Benefits
- Enhanced Penalty for Future Crimes
- No Firearm Privileges as an Adult
- Deportation

# CHARGES YOU COULD FACE IF YOU THREATEN A SCHOOL:

- Communicating a threat of terrorism MCL 750.543m - 20 year felony
- Calling in a bomb threat MCL 750.411a(3)(a) - 4 year felony
- Threatening violence against school, employee, or student MCL 750.235b(1) -1 year misdemeanor
- Malicious use of a phone or computer MCL 750.540e -6 month misdemeanor
