St. Clair Shores Woman Guilty as Charged in Drunk Driving Crash

Mount Clemens, MI - On Friday, December 1, 2023, a Macomb County jury convicted 33- year-old Shanara Reed on all charges after a four-day jury trial by Assistant Prosecutor Richard Nelson.

On Thursday, June 25, 2020, Reed was an at-fault driver in a head-on collision in Chesterfield Twp. hitting a family of three. Reed lied to the police officers and told them someone else was driving the vehicle. Reed was taken to the hospital for her injuries. After further investigation police arrested Reed for the collision.

Shanara Reed was charged with Operating While Intoxicated Causing Serious Impairment (five year felony), Driving While License Suspended Causing Serious Impairment (five year felony), Lying to a Peace Office (two year high court misdemeanor), and Moving Violation Causing Serious Impairment (93 day misdemeanor).

"The Macomb County jury delivered a resounding verdict that shows our resolve to protect our community and seek justice for the victims," said Macomb County Prosecutor Peter J. Lucido.
