Shelby Twp. Man Who Allegedly Stabbed His Mother Faces Additional Charges

Mount Clemens, MI - Today, the Macomb County Prosecutor's Office authorized additional charges for 30-year-old Miles Farish of Shelby Twp.

It is alleged that on Tuesday, January 9, 2024, Miles Farish stabbed his mother multiple times while she was asleep in her bed. Shelby Township Police responded to the incident and Farish allegedly assaulted three police officers when they were attempting to arrest him.

Farish was charged and arraigned on Assault with Intent to Murder (life felony) for the stabbing of his mother. After an independent investigation by the Macomb County Sheriff's Department, the Macomb County Prosecutor's Office has added additional charges of three counts of Assault with a Dangerous Weapon (four year felonies), and three counts of Assaulting/Resisting/Obstructing a Police Officer (two year felonies).

On Friday, January 12, 2024, Farish was arraigned on the Assault with Intent to Murder charge in Shelby Twp. District Court by Magistrate Jim VerPloeg where bond was set at \$2 million cash only. Farish was referred to Community Corrections for a mental health evaluation. An arraignment date for the new charges has not been scheduled at this time.

"We will vigorously pursue justice for those who brazenly assault our law enforcement officers. Such acts not only jeopardize the safety of those who protect our communities but also undermine the very fabric of a society built on respect for the rule of law," said Macomb County Prosecutor Peter J. Lucido.

The Macomb County Prosecutor's Office represents the people. We are committed to achieving justice and following the laws of the State of Michigan. All that are accused of a crime are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
