Demonstrator Arraigned for Assaulting a Police Officer at a President Biden Rally

Mount Clemens, MI - Today, a Melvindale man was arraigned in connection with allegedly assaulting a police officer while demonstrating against President Biden at a political rally.

On Thursday, February 1, 2024, President Biden came to the City of Warren to attend a political rally. Before the event, demonstrators lawfully demonstrated against the President. It is alleged during that time that demonstrator Maherr Salah Jaeran, age 21, assaulted a police officer.

Maherr Jaeran was charged with Assaulting/Resisting/Obstructing a Police Officer (two year felony). Jaeran was arraigned in 37th Warren District Court where District Court Judge John Chmura set a \$5,000 personal bond. A Probable Cause Hearing is scheduled for Tuesday, February 13, 2024 at 8:45 am by District Court Judge Suzanne Faunce.

"When an individual allegedly assaults a police officer on duty during a peaceful demonstration – they not only attack an individual but assault the very fabric of our society. Our duty as prosecutors is to ensure that such acts are met with the full force of the law," said Macomb County Prosecutor Peter J. Lucido.
