Parole Revoked After Man Charged with Assault

Mount Clemens, MI - A Sterling Heights man's parole was revoked in connection with an alleged assault in Clinton Twp.

It is alleged that on Friday, December 29, 2023, Fred Ayers and a co-defendant were asked to leave Freddy's Bar in Clinton Township after throwing beer bottles. The two men got into a physical altercation with two bouncers inside and outside of the bar.

Fred Ayers, 49 years old, was charged with Assault with Intent to do Great Bodily Harm less than Murder or Strangulation (10 year felony), Assault (93 day misdemeanor). He is also charged as a habitual fourth offender (minimum 25 years in prison). A court date has not been set for the Macomb County Prosecutor's Office to arraign Ayers on these charges.

On Monday, February 5, 2024, Ayers' parole was revoked due to these charges and he is in the Michigan Department of Corrections custody as a parole violator. Ayers was paroled on Tuesday, July 25, 2023 after serving seven years in prison for carjacking.

"I am committed to keeping Macomb County safe and will charge those who harm people in our community," said Macomb County Prosecutor Peter J. Lucido.

The Macomb County Prosecutor's Office represents the people. We are committed to achieving justice and following the laws of the State of Michigan. All that are accused of a crime are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
