Garfield Road between 14 Mile Road and 15 Mile Road

What is being done?

The Macomb County Department of Roads (MCDR) will reconstruct Garfield Road between 14 Mile Road and 15 Mile Road. The project includes new road drainage, curb and gutter, concrete pavement, traffic signals, and replacement of the Harrington Drain. The project will widen Garfield Road to three lanes with a northbound lane, southbound lane and a center turn lane.

When will work take place?

The project will be completed in stages.

Estimated duration

July 2024 – August 2025

July 2024 to August 2024

- Temporary road widening on the west side of the Garfield Road

December 2024 to January 2025

- Harrington Drain replacement

March 2025 to August 2025

- Road reconstruction

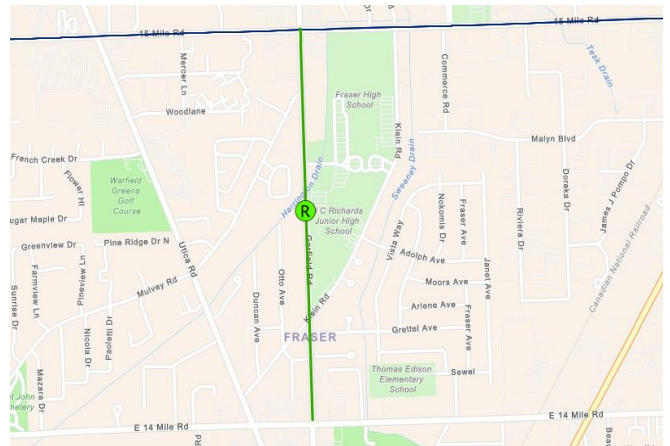
All dates are estimates and the project schedule is subject to change.

Traffic

Garfield Road will maintain one northbound lane of traffic during construction operations with the southbound lane being detoured to Utica Road. Garfield Road will be closed for a short period of time at the Harrington Drain for culvert replacement work.

Access to all residential and business properties will be maintained throughout the duration of the project. Some inconvenience may occur during construction operations, and you may be contacted by county or contractor personnel to help minimize disruptions prior to or during the project.
